

The Department of Pathology, Reproduction and One Health from the Faculty of Agriculture and Veterinarian Sciences, São Paulo State University (FVCAV-Unesp), Jaboticabal-SP, Brazil, makes public the opening of applications for a postdoctoral fellowship in the area of **Microbiome of Ectoparasites**. This postdoctoral fellowship will be linked to a Thematic project funded by the São Paulo State Research Foundation (FAPESP), entitled "Unravelling the relationship between Bartonella spp. and arthropod-vectors by "OMICS" approaches and tick cell lines culture" (Grant #2022/05615-2), working mainly on bioinformatics, aiming at analyzing the microbiome of ticks, fleas and mites.

The selected postdoctoral fellow will receive the FAPESP scholarship, which will be valid for two (2) years.

To fill this vacancy it is necessary that the candidate meet the following requirements:

- 1) Ph.D.;
- 2) Experience with research on molecular techniques and bioinformatics (microbiome analysis).

The required registration documents are:

- 1) Curriculum Vitae. List of publication in the last 5 years.
- 2) PhD diploma or proof of doctoral defense;
- 3) Cover letter showing the pre-requisites required;
- 4) Two letters of reference;

The application deadline is October, 10th, 2018.
